For on-campus users

Pre-configuration is required for Wi-Fi access.

■ Things to check before connecting:

- ① It does not run on ARM-based Windows. Please visit the technical support team office for assistance.
- ② The downloaded file may not run in Chrome.


 In this case, you need to go to the "Downloads" folder and run the file from there.
- 3 If a Microsoft SmartScreen warning message appears, click "More info" and then proceed by clicking "Run".
- Wireless Manager (Anyclick) users: Please delete the program before proceeding.
 Refer to the separate agent removal manual for instructions.





① Please disconnect from all Wi-Fi connections and connect to "Yonsei_Setup".




② When a new window appears, click on the "installation file" to download it.





- ③ Existing Wireless Manager (Anyclick) users should delete the Wireless Manager and proceed. (refer to separate agent removal manual) If you are a first-time user, proceed to step ④.



When you run the downloaded "Wi-Fi Profile Installer", you can see that the installation is proceeding as shown in the picture.







■ Connection Procedure


- When a message like the one shown in the image appears in the lower right corner, click on it.(If the message does not appear, attempt to connect to "Yonsei" and proceed to step 4)




